

## *The Kenites*

There is a place referred to in the Old Testament that no one has ever found or ever proved that it existed; **the Land of Nod**.

No encyclopedia, no past research and nowhere in the Scriptures can its physical location be found, other than the short description of, **East of Eden**.

There is little point in rehashing theoretical places or associating this place with Atlantis or some other speculation that can be argued with no hope of any definitive answer.

But the **Land of Nod** was indeed the place that Cain went after our Father punished him for killing his brother Abel. The people in Land of Nod were most certainly a part of the **sixth-day creation**.

*Genesis 4:16 And Cain went out from the presence of the Lord, and dwelt in the land of Nod, on the east of Eden.*

Was the Land of Nod a real place or was it just a figure of speech that denotes a way of life? The word **Nod** itself means **wandering** and this makes complete sense because in **Genesis 4:12** our Father said that Cain would be a **wanderer** and would have no success in raising his own crops;

*Genesis 4:12 When thou tillest the ground, it shall not henceforth yield unto thee her strength; a fugitive and a vagabond shalt thou be in the earth. KJV*

A punishment that he and his children would forever endure.

Our Lord told the Apostles one time that there are things written of that a lot of people would not understand. These were called **secrets** or **mysteries**; some were even called **parables**, and it was given that only those with eyes to see and ears to hear would understand the true meaning and it takes the Holy Spirit and His touch to give you those eyes and ears.

Understanding the prophesies of Ezekiel, Daniel, Jeremiah and others sheds a good bit of light on future events which should concern all of us but understanding past events is even more vital, for those events build the foundation that allows the light of prophesy to make sense to us.

To understand why our Father punished Cain in the way that He did we have to understand the **circumstances of his conception**. Comprehending the **first six chapters of Genesis** will give you the key of David to the Scriptures, in a lot of respects, for there is an untold volume of information therein that is ignored and never taught but, when properly explained and understood, will probably make you step back and say "oh, my!"

**Genesis, chapter 3**, begins to unveil the truth of Cain's conception and I'll begin with verse one;

*Genesis 3: 1 Now the serpent was more subtil than any beast of the field which the Lord God had made. And he said unto the woman, Yea, hath God said, Ye shall not eat of every tree of the garden? KJV*

Is this really a snake talking here? No, of course not. Let's cut to the chase and find out who this **snake** really is;

*Revelation 12:9 And the **great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.** KJV*

Satan goes by many names throughout the Scriptures, depending on which particular role he is playing at the time, in his efforts to deceive us. His first name, in the world that was, was Lucifer, the shining morning star; his second name, in the Garden, is the Serpent, the glistening one.

This serpent is Satan himself in a glorious spiritual body.

*Genesis 3:2 And the woman said unto the **serpent**, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: KJV*

*Genesis 3:3 But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die. KJV*

*Genesis 3:4 And the **serpent** said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die: KJV*

*Genesis 3:5 For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil. KJV*

Notice the lower case **g** on the word **god**. It's **not** referring to the Supreme Father.

*Genesis 3:6 And when the woman saw that the tree was good for food, and that it was pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make one wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat. KJV*

Both Adam and Eve succumbed to the lies of the serpent, the devil, Satan. They both found out that he was more than just **pleasant to the eyes**.

*Genesis 3:7 And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they were naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons. KJV*

*Genesis 3:8 And they heard the voice of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God amongst the trees of the garden. KJV*

*Genesis 3:9 And the Lord God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where art thou? KJV*

*Genesis 3:10 And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself. KJV*

*Genesis 3:11 And he said, Who told thee that thou wast naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat? KJV*

*Genesis 3:12 And the man said, The woman whom thou gavest to be with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat. KJV*

*Genesis 3:13 And the Lord God said unto the woman, What is this that thou hast done? And the woman said, The serpent **beguiled** me, and I did eat. KJV*

**The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat.** Satan didn't convince Eve that the apple would taste very good; **Satan convinced Eve to partake of himself.**

★ **Beguiled**, H5377, **nasha'**, a primitive root; to lead astray, i.e. (mentally) to delude, or (morally) to seduce.

Now, before you get all bent out of shape by me declaring that Satan had carnal knowledge of Eve, and you tell me that I'm full of it because Satan wasn't in a flesh and blood body and it would be impossible for an entity in a spiritual body to do that sort of thing, please consider this;

*Genesis 6:1 And it came to pass, when men began to multiply on the face of the earth, and daughters were born unto them, KJV*

This does not have anything to do with the six-day creation of man and woman, this has to do with the Hebrew race, namely, **the children of Adam and Eve**. There is not a whole lot written concerning this six-day creation because the focus of the Scriptures, basically, are the people through whom the Savior would come, Christ the Messiah. The Hebrews. His chosen people;

*Deuteronomy 7:6 For thou art an holy people unto the Lord thy God: the Lord thy God hath chosen thee to be a special people unto himself, above all people that are upon the face of the earth. KJV*

Continuing with Genesis;

*Genesis 6:2 That the sons of God saw the daughters of men that they were fair; and they took them wives of all which they chose. KJV*

The key to the subject of these verses is the phrase **sons of God**. How this phrase is used in Scripture:

- ★ *Adam is called a **son of God** in Luke 3:38.*
- ★ *People who are **in Christ**, that is, believe on Him, are called sons of God.*
- ★ *Every other place in the Old Testament, the phrase **sons of God**, refers to angels. Good angels, bad angels, doesn't matter.*

The very fact that angels, *in heaven*, in spiritual bodies, were desirous of **earthly women**, shows that there is more to the spiritual body than we have been led to believe; or maybe not led to believe, maybe you don't know very much about angels at all.

Angels can eat the same food that we do; in **Exodus 16:15**, earthly man ate angels' food; Genesis 19:1-3, angels ate man's food;

*Exodus 16:15 And when the children of Israel saw it, they said one to another, It is manna: for they wist not what it was. And Moses said unto them, This is the bread which the Lord hath given you to eat. KJV*

A literal translation of the word **manna**, in the Hebrew, means *what is it?* You can imagine that it fell from the sky like snowflakes. Man is eating angels' food.

*Genesis 19:1 And there came **two angels** to Sodom at even; and Lot sat in the gate of Sodom: and Lot seeing them rose up to meet them; and he bowed himself with his face toward the ground; KJV*

*Genesis 19:2 And he said, Behold now, my lords, turn in, I pray you, into your servant's house, and tarry all night, and wash your feet, and ye shall rise up early, and go on your ways. And they said, Nay; but we will abide in the street all night. KJV*

*Genesis 19:3 And he pressed upon them greatly; and they turned in unto him, and entered into his house; and he made them a feast, and did bake unleavened bread, and **they did eat**. KJV*

There came **two angels**. No problem with the translation on that one. Two angels.

Lot convinced them to spend the night in his house and not on the street and he made them a feast, and baked unleavened bread *and they did eat*. Angels are eating mans' food.

Now we should have a better idea of what the spiritual body is capable of doing, eating and sleeping and desiring women just like an earthly body does.

And it should not be too difficult to understand that Eve and Satan, that glorious cherubim that our Father created in the full pattern, have had carnal knowledge of one another.

The question should have crossed your mind as to *why Satan would want to party with Eve*. Just to have a good time? Not by a long shot.

Satan, in his wisdom, has figured out that the reason that our Father created earthly bodies for all the *host of heaven*, was because fully one-third of all souls created by our Father, chose to follow Satan when he began his siege on the Mercy Seat and his attempt to dethrone God and sit in the Holy Place himself in the *age that was*, as Peter so eloquently put it.

Our Father had to decide whether to destroy all of His creation or place all souls in a temporary body, for a short period of time, and allow us to make that decision of eternal life through Christ or a good time on this earth with their buddy Satan and a spiritual death at the culmination of that.

Bottom line is that Satan knows that the Hebrew race is created specifically for the emergence of the Messiah thousands of years down the road. But if he could just pollute that bloodline he could stop that from happening. That's the reason he wanted to party hearty with Eve. And impregnate her with **his offspring. His child.**

Mission accomplished.

Let's skip further in time and see how the birth of Cain came about.

*Genesis 4:1 And Adam knew Eve his wife; and she conceived, and bare Cain, and said, I have gotten a man from the Lord. KJV*

Now it's time for Adam to have carnal knowledge of Eve, as was our Father's original intention. It was not part of our Father's plan for Satan to have his way with Eve at all; it was a freewill decision on Eve's part to do that.

Now it says in the above verse that soon after that happened she gave birth to Cain but don't let the wording confuse you into thinking that immediately following the copulation between Adam and Eve that the birth of Cain was the direct result. There is no indication of any length of time between Eve and Satan and Eve and Adam; the birth of Cain was not a direct result of an act of copulation between Eve and Adam.

*Genesis 4:2 And she again bare his brother Abel. And Abel was a keeper of sheep, but Cain was a tiller of the ground. KJV*

It's very important that you understand the meaning of the word **again**, and it is;

★ **Again**, H3254, **yacaph**, a primitive root; to add or augment (often adverbial, **to continue to do a thing**)

There was not a nine month period of time between the birth of Cain and the birth of Abel. After Cain was born Eve continued in the birthing process and delivered Able. Eve was giving birth to a set of twins.

Is this just a reckless assumption or is there evidence of this?

*Genesis 4:3 And in process of time it came to pass, that Cain brought of the fruit of the ground an offering unto the Lord. KJV*

This offering from Cain would probably have been produce from the fields he had cultivated, along with oil and incense.

*Genesis 4:4 And Abel, he also brought of the firstlings of his flock and of the fat thereof. And the Lord had respect unto Abel and to his offering: KJV*

Abel would have brought an animal from his herd or flocks for a blood sacrifice.

The important thing to observe here is that both of these men **came of age** at the same time, fulfilling the Law of our Father together, which gives strong indication that these two people were born at the same time, or twins.

*Genesis 4:5 But unto Cain and to his offering he had not respect. And Cain was very wroth, and his countenance fell. KJV*

If Cain is the offspring of Satan it would not be hard to understand why our Father would not have respect for his offering.

*Genesis 4:6 And the Lord said unto Cain, Why art thou wroth? and why is thy countenance fallen? KJV*

*Genesis 4:7 If thou doest well, shalt thou not be accepted? and if thou doest not well, sin lieth at the door. And unto thee shall be his desire, and thou shalt rule over him. KJV*

*Genesis 4:8 And Cain talked with Abel his brother: and it came to pass, when they were in the field, that Cain rose up against Abel his brother, and slew him. KJV*

This makes Cain the **first recorded murderer in the Bible**, not the first murderer within the human race. Genesis does not concern itself with the Gentiles, the sixth-day creation.

It's astounding to me that religion completely ignores the reality of the **sixth-day creation** and it's taught that Cain was the first murderer among all mankind. Is this shortsightedness or just plain ignorance?

On the other hand, as a child in school I was taught that Christopher Columbus discovered America, while in another class, I was told that Americus Vespucci did that and he's the reason that we were called America.

And even that is not the full truth of it all. The Indians were already here; the Vikings made many trips to the area of the New England states; there is evidence of the Celts being here and even priests from the Holy Land have left their mark as far west as Arizona, long before Columbus ever climbed on board that ship.

Doesn't anybody get anything right? And it gets worse as each generation comes along because the school systems routinely **rewrite** history. I've been told that in some history books George Washington is mentioned on only one page throughout the entire book.

We are paying for intellectual indifference even today. Kids are coming out of school dumber than when they went in, many cannot read or write, and these are the people that will run the businesses and government in a few short years. Heaven help us all.

What other evidence can we find to support the contention that **Cain is the spawn of Satan?**

Cain is not listed in the genealogy of Adam. It's understandable that Abel isn't listed for he was murdered by Cain and had no chance of offspring but, if Cain were the son of Adam and Eve, why isn't he listed there?

It was very important for the Hebrew people to keep accurate records of births and deaths. In the book of Matthew you can find the complete regal/legal line of Christ and in Luke you can find the natural/legal genealogy of Him.

Every birth was recorded with meticulous care and yet Cain is not listed with Adam. Let's take a look for ourselves;

*Genesis 5:3 And Adam lived an hundred and thirty years, and begat a son in his own likeness, after his image; and called his name Seth: KJV*

Adam was 130 years old when he had his son Seth but remember that Seth followed the birth of Cain and Abel.

*Genesis 5:4 And the days of Adam after he had begotten Seth were eight hundred years: and he begat sons and daughters: KJV*

Adam lived another 800 years after the birth of Seth and had other sons and daughters but they do not have an impact on our Father's plan so their names are not listed in the genealogy.

*Genesis 5:5 And all the days that Adam lived were nine hundred and thirty years: and he died. KJV*

And Adam died. Let me point out again that the only progeny or child accounted for in Adam's genealogy is Seth. Abel is not listed because he was murdered and is dead. Cain is still alive but not listed because **he is not of the offspring of Adam. His mother was Eve but his father was Satan.**

Looking at the genealogy of Cain in chapter four of Genesis only gives us the sons and daughters that he had, not who his father was.

We have exhausted the possibilities of discovering the printed words that tell us who the father of Cain really was; we can further determine who his father was by indications from other people and Scriptures.

The most telling example of this is can be found in the book of **1<sup>st</sup> John**;

*1<sup>st</sup> John 3:12 Not as Cain, who was of that wicked one, and slew his brother. And wherefore slew he him? Because his own works were evil, and his brother's righteous. KJV*

John very plainly tells us that the **father of Cain was the wicked one**. Who is this wicked one?

In **Matthew, chapter 13**, our Lord is giving the people a couple of parables. The first one, the parable of the sower, our Lord is explaining how different people hear and understand the truth of the Scriptures. Some have eyes that see and ears that hear but others do not. Here is the first part of that parable;

*Matthew 13:18 Hear ye therefore the parable of the sower. KJV*

*Matthew 13:19 When any one heareth the word of the kingdom, and understandeth it not, **then cometh the wicked one**, and catcheth away that which was sown in his heart. This is he which received seed by the way side. KJV*

If anyone hears the Word of God and doesn't understand it, it leaves the door wide open for Satan to come in and add to the confusion. He comes in and takes away what little truth that person had.

**The "wicked one" is Satan.**

Our Lord continues and gives another parable;

*Matthew 13:24 Another parable put he forth unto them, saying, The kingdom of heaven is likened unto a man which sowed good seed in his field: KJV*

*Matthew 13:25 But while men slept, his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat, and went his way. KJV*

The enemy is Satan and the tares are the **children of Cain, the Kenites**.

*Matthew 13:26 But when the blade was sprung up, and brought forth fruit, then appeared the tares also. KJV*

*Matthew 13:27 So the servants of the householder came and said unto him, Sir, didst not thou sow good seed in thy field? from whence then hath it tares? KJV*

*Matthew 13:28 He said unto them, An enemy hath done this. The servants said unto him, Wilt thou then that we go and gather them up? KJV*

*Matthew 13:29 But he said, Nay; lest while ye gather up the tares, ye root up also the wheat with them. KJV*

*Matthew 13:30 Let both grow together until the harvest: and in the time of harvest I will say to the reapers, Gather ye together first the tares, and bind them in bundles to burn them: but gather the wheat into my barn. KJV*

Lest we continue on without a good understanding of the meaning of this parable, our Lord gives us an explanation of it;

*Matthew 13:35 That it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, saying, I will open my mouth in parables; I will utter things which have been kept secret from the foundation of the world. KJV*

*Matthew 13:36 Then Jesus sent the multitude away, and went into the house: and his disciples came unto him, saying, Declare unto us the parable of the tares of the field. KJV*

*Matthew 13:37 He answered and said unto them, He that soweth the good seed is the Son of man; KJV*

Jesus Christ.

*Matthew 13:38 The field is the world; the good seed are the children of the kingdom; but the tares are the children of the wicked one; KJV*

*Matthew 13:39 The enemy that sowed them is the devil; the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels. KJV*

*Matthew 13:40 As therefore the tares are gathered and burned in the fire; so shall it be in the end of this world. KJV*

**The tares are the children of the wicked one. The wicked one is Satan, the father of Cain.**

**The Kenites are called the sons of Cain.**

Alright. How does the word **Kenites** come into play now? Let's look at the Hebrew meaning of the word to start with;

★ **Kenite**, H7014, **qayin**, the same as OT:7013 (with a play upon the affinity to OT:7069); **Kajin**, **the name of the first child**, also of a place in Palestine, **and of an Oriental tribe**.

Need I remind you of who was **the first child born of Adam and Eve**? It's not talking about the sixth-day creation.

*Genesis 4:1 And Adam knew Eve his wife; and she conceived, and bare Cain, and said, I have gotten a man from the Lord. KJV*

*Genesis 4:2 And she again bare his brother Abel. And Abel was a keeper of sheep, but Cain was a tiller of the ground. KJV*

**Cain was the first born of Eve.**

You will also notice in the description of **qayin**, or **Kenite**, that it can also refer to an Oriental tribe called the Kenites as well. Some people will quickly point out to you that the father-in-law of Moses was called a Kenite. Does this mean that, if we trace back the heritage of Moses, that he was a son of Cain as well?

No, it means that foolish people are speaking foolish things.

There is only one place in the Old Testament where Moses is mentioned as being associated with the Kenites in some way;

*Judges 4:11 Now Heber the Kenite, which was of the children of Hobab the father in law of Moses, had severed himself from the Kenites, and pitched his tent unto the plain of Zaanaim, which is by Kedesh. KJV*

The father of the wife of Moses was a Kenite, Moses was not. The genealogy of Moses goes back to Jacob;

★ **Moses**

★ **Ahram--Father**

★ **Korath--Grandfather**

★ **Levi----Great Grandfather**

★ **Jacob—Great, Great Grandfather**

You are going to run into a lot of difficulty if you do word searches and such, using Bible software, trying to nail down the fact that the **Kenites** are the **sons of Cain**.

There are only 14 verses that contain the word Kenite or Kenites and, with one exception, all define the Kenites as a member of a Tribe called Kajin. This is **not** what you will find if you take the name Cain back to its original meaning.

**Cain, in the Hebrew dictionary, is H7014** while every other occurrence is H7017 and it's H7014 that gives us the description of **the name of the first child**. Beyond that we have references by others that Cain is the son of Satan.

For instance;

*1<sup>st</sup> John 3:12 Not as Cain, who was of that wicked one, and slew his brother. And wherefore slew he him? Because his own works were evil, and his brother's righteous. KJV*

Cain is the son of the "wicked one", which we know was another name for Satan.

How about some info from the mouth of Christ Himself? Christ was speaking to a group of men who **called** themselves of **Judah** but were not.

*John 8:44 Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it. KJV*

**He was a murderer from the beginning.** Who was the first Biblical murderer? Cain, of course.

Now, these people that Christ was speaking to claimed to be of Judah but, in fact, were not. They claimed to be **loudaios** but they really weren't.

*John 8:31 Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; KJV*

☆ **Jews is loudaios**, G2453, from NT:2448 (in the sense of NT:2455 **as a country**); Judaeans, i.e. belonging to Judah:

**loudaios** means people from the Tribe of Judah. Not of the eleven other Tribes, just of Judah.

How did it come to be that the Kenites started to be called Jews and were intermingled with true Judah? Let's go to Genesis and see who the sons of Cain were back in those days;

*Genesis 15:18 In the same day the Lord made a covenant with Abram, saying, Unto thy seed have I given this land, from the river of Egypt unto the great river, the river Euphrates: KJV*

*Genesis 15:19 The Kenites, and the Kenizzites, and the Kadmonites, KJV*

*Genesis 15:20 And the Hittites, and the Perizzites, and the Rephaims, KJV*

*Genesis 15:21 And the Amorites, and the Canaanites, and the Girgashites, and the Jebusites. KJV*

The descendants of Cain had been quite busy. There are ten Kenite tribes listed above. When our Father said **unto thy seed have I given this land**, the land that He is talking about giving to the Israelites is the **Promised Land**.

The enemy, the tribes of the sons of Cain, were already dwelling there. Quite the reason that our Father told them to kill and destroy all the people and cities when they get there.

But they didn't do that. Big mistake. Instead they made covenants and treaties with them. Why? I don't think that they ever had enough confidence and faith in our Father to get down and dirty with these Kenites. I don't think that they understood the gravity of the situation. They were afraid of giants and that's all there was to it.

Satan isn't stupid; he knew the Plan of our Father and that was to create a special race through which the Messiah would come. Satan had already staked out the land, possessed it and was ready to wage war against the Israelites when they showed up. And the Israelites didn't even put up a fight.

We step ahead in time and we find the Kenites fearing for their wellbeing, these are the Kenites speaking;

*Jeremiah 35:11 But it came to pass, when Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon came up into the land, that we said, Come, and let us go to Jerusalem for fear of the army of the Chaldeans, and for fear of the army of the Syrians: so we dwell at Jerusalem. KJV*

They were going to **hide in plain sight** by going to live in Jerusalem and intermingling with the people of the Tribe of Judah and why not? They looked just like everybody else in Jerusalem.

But they never forgot who they really were. Their hatred of the Jews did not abate over the years. And then one day this Man comes to town who calls Himself the Messiah.

And they knew that He really was, He was everything that was good and righteous, and if they could just get Him out of the way permanently their father, Satan, would have a better chance of deceiving and corrupting souls.

Our Lord is speaking before a crowd intermingled with the Jews of Judah and those that call themselves Jews, the Kenites. He has been accused of blasphemy and this is what He had to say;

*John 8:31 Then said Jesus to those Jews which believed on him, If ye continue in my word, then are ye my disciples indeed; KJV*

The separator in this verse is **those Jews which believed on Him** clearly indicates that they were a mixed crowd of people. Some believed on Him and some didn't.

*John 8:32 And ye shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. KJV*

*John 8:33 They answered him, We be Abraham's seed, and were never in bondage to any man: how sayest thou, Ye shall be made free? KJV*

*John 8:34 Jesus answered them, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Whosoever committeth sin is the servant of sin. KJV*

*John 8:35 And the servant abideth not in the house for ever: but the Son abideth ever. KJV*

*John 8:36 If the Son therefore shall make you free, ye shall be free indeed. KJV*

*John 8:37 I know that ye are Abraham's seed; but ye seek to kill me, because my word hath no place in you. KJV*

**If these people are the sons of Cain how could they be of the seed of Abraham?** Adam and Eve were the beginning of that seed line which gives Cain a genealogical connection, at least, a half part.

*John 8:38 I speak that which I have seen with my Father: and ye do that which ye have seen with your father. KJV*

Take special notice of the two words **father**. One is capitalized while the other is not. The first is referring to our Father while the second is referring to the father of the Kenites, Satan.

*John 8:39 They answered and said unto him, Abraham is our father. Jesus saith unto them, If ye were Abraham's children, ye would do the works of Abraham. KJV*

*John 8:40 But now ye seek to kill me, a man that hath told you the truth, which I have heard of God: this did not Abraham. KJV*

It wasn't the Jews of Judah that wanted to kill Him but the **loudaios, the Kenites**.

*John 8:41 Ye do the deeds of your father. Then said they to him, We be not born of fornication; we have one Father, even God. KJV*

They can argue with Christ all they want but He still knows the truth about them.

*John 8:42 Jesus said unto them, If God were your Father, ye would love me: for I proceeded forth and came from God; neither came I of myself, but he sent me. KJV*

*John 8:43 Why do ye not understand my speech? even because ye cannot hear my word. KJV*

They don't listen to Christ, they listen to Satan.

*John 8:44 **Ye are of your father the devil, and the lusts of your father ye will do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and abode not in the truth, because there is no truth in him. When he speaketh a lie, he speaketh of his own: for he is a liar, and the father of it.***

Can't get any plainer than that, people. **Ye are of your father the devil** and who was the first murderer? Cain. Who is Cain? The son of Eve and Satan.

I could go on a little further with this but I think that verse 44 nails it pretty good.

Satan beguiled Eve in the Garden and that was his first attempt to pollute the bloodline through which Jesus Christ would come. The Fallen Angels marrying the daughters of Adam was the next attempt and precipitated the Flood of Noah's time.

Many people believe that this flood was world-wide but I do not. The offspring of the union between angelic beings with flesh and blood women produced **giants** and if allowed to live may have endangered the existence of the entire human race.

Our Lord told us to leave the Kenites alone and we should do well to follow that advice. Certainly He knows them better than we do.

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
